

Materials Needed:

HOOP: 4 x 4 hoop

(Embroidery Field Needed: 3.54 x 3.61)

STABILIZER: Cut-away stabilizer

Fabric 1:

(outer fabric)

5 x 13"

Fabric 2:

(lining)

5 x 13"

OTHER:

- -Zipper (6", non-metal teeth)
- -Tape (a low-tack tape is best, such as washi tape or paper tape)
- -Batting $4^{1}/2 \times 4^{1}/2$ "
- -Ribbon (1) 1 1/2" length of 3/8" wide ribbon
- -Metal Key Ring

Cut the Following:

From Fabric 1: (Outer Fabric)

Cut (3) 4 x 4" blocks

From Fabric 2: (Lining Fabric)

Cut (3) 4 x 4" blocks
