

Pinwheel

Yardage and cutting:

1 yard – Focus squares & outer border

½ yard – Fabric A for Pinwheels

½ yard – Fabric B for Pinwheels

¼ yard – Inner Border

Cutting:

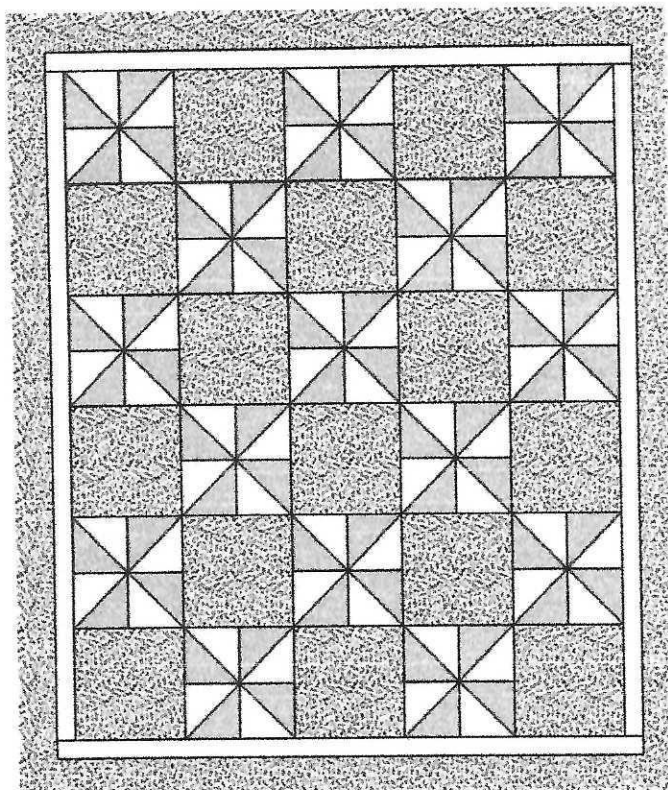
Focus Fabric

- Cut (3) 6 ½" strips by width of fabric. Sub-cut into (15) 6 ½" squares
- Cut (4) 3 ½" strips by width of fabric for outer borders

Fabric A and Fabric B

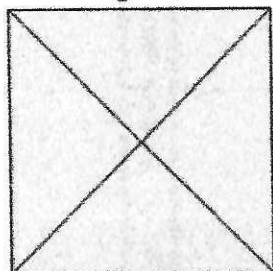
- Cut (2) 9" strips by width of fabric of both A and B and Sub-cut into 4 – 9" squares of each fabric.

Inner Border Cut (4) 1 ½" strips by width of fabric.



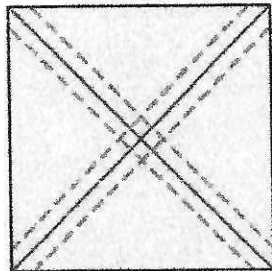
Pinwheel Block Assembly:

Diagram 1



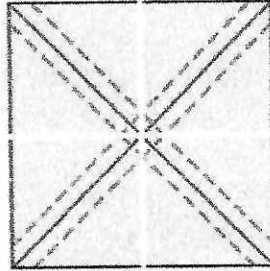
Place (2) squares with right sides together. Draw a line diagonally corner to corner using a mechanical pencil or Frixion pen.

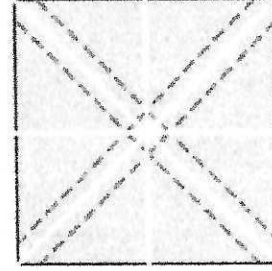
Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn lines.

Cut the squares in both directions.

Cut squares diagonally corner to corner

- Square up each half-square triangle unit to 3 ½"
- Sew two of the half-square triangle units together as shown in Diagram 5.
- Sew two of these sections together as shown in Diagram 6. Make 15 – 6 1/2" blocks.
- Sew 6 rows of 5 blocks each, alternating the Pinwheel and Focus blocks.
- Sew the rows together

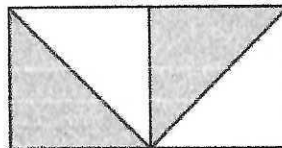
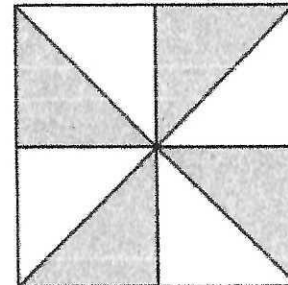

- Add inner borders (sides first, then top and bottom).
- Add outer borders (sides first, then top and bottom).
