

Churn Dash
9" block

Background White

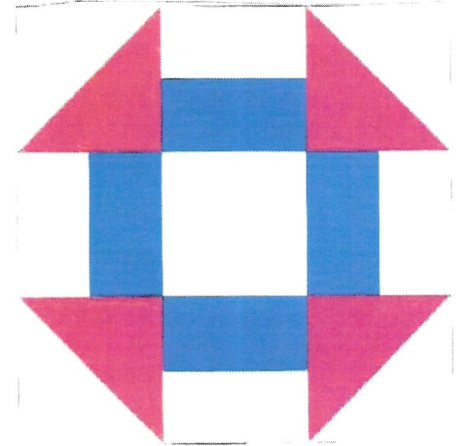
- 1 Strip 2" x 15"
- 2 Squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"
- 1 Square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Red

- 2 Squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"

Blue

- 1 Strip 2" x 15"



Sew the white strip to the blue strip.
press towards the blue.
cut that unit into 4 3 1/2" squares

Take the 3 7/8" white squares and mark a diagonal line from corner to corner.

Lay a white square on top of a red square right sides together and sew 1/4" away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line, press towards the red.

Lay the block out as shown and sew it together just like a 9 patch.

If you use a fat quarter of each color you should be able to make 2 or 3 blocks!
